### Welcome Shannon

Shannon called the meeting to order. She also acknowledged the presence of incoming parents at the meeting.

# Principal/VP Report Toby

Toby expressed his thanks on behalf of the entire staff for Staff Appreciation week. The support of the Community has been appreciated throughout the year. The staff is now focusing on closure and preparation for summer.

### **Teacher Report** Diane

Diane reported that writing instruction is going well. The Youngers have been studying Balance and Motion using a Foss Science kit.

They are also incorporating concepts from Cirque de Soleil. The Youngers loved Spring Camp. Diane presented some small gifts/awards to participants and leaders at Spring Camp.

#### Carol

Carol expressed her appreciation for all the gestures of parents during Staff Appreciation week. She reported that the Middles will go on their last field trip of the year on 5/29 to Tillicum Village. The Middles are involved in an Oregon Trail simulation unit in which they are participating enthusiastically. They are studying the Physics of Sound in Science. They have had a professional sound technician as a guest in the classroom from the Kirkland Heritage Society. He has been doing sound effects since the 1940's and is giving input on the Oregon Trail unit. He provided each of the students with a CD containing soundtracks from the original Archie radio shows. Carol also reported that the Third Grade Swim is going well.

#### Monica

Monica reported that an Artist in Residence has been visiting the classroom twice weekly. The Olders have also been using a Motion and Design unit in Science, for which they made three-dimensional paper creations. Donna led an art project using recycled household items. The Olders have also been following a story path of Colonial Boston in Social Studies. They have been working in "family groups" in which they are developing characters and creating a mural.

# Treasurer's Report/2008-09 Budget Approval Sara

Sara reported that according to the Financial Report dated 5/1/08, member contributions were under budget by \$442. Member contributions can be made at any time. Expenditures have been \$6,000 less than budget. There are still many expenditures that are being processed.

Sara distributed the 2008/09 budget. She noted the following changes: slight changes in the graduation budget, addition of \$150 for graduation gifts, increased budget for Community Service by \$100, and an addition in the budget for the email server. A motion was made to approve the budget. This motion was passed.

# **Volunteer Report** Anne

The org chart was posted at the meeting for the Community to sign up. New families were encouraged to sign up as well. Anne is looking for a Co-Volunteer Coordinator for next year to help her expand the role. A request for two more volunteers for Graduation help was fulfilled.
