- · Apologize for cancellation of November meeting
- School Levy year this year here are facts
 - 2010 Feb is levy vote; there is lots of info on the Lake Washington website (http://www.lwsd.org/News/Levy-and-Bond-Information/Pages/default.aspx)
 - The school district is calling registered voters asking if they will be voting for the levy; if folks say they will vote for the levy, then they will get a reminder call in February
 - The proceeds of the levy covers maintenance and facility issues, etc and large capital expense
 - The new model of reconfiguration is contingent on the levy passing due to the issues with space in schools. Do not know how a passage of the levy will change DCS (if there is a move to the K-5; 6-8; 9-12 structure) Mark has a meeting on 3 December where this issue may come up on.
 - This levy also adds choice schools in other levels expanding the secondary options






Look here for all events; options on the page allow you to set up many different ways of being notified about events including RSS feeds (as demonstrated in the picture below –
