Principal's Report

- We are down a copier at the school. One of the copiers was given to another school. We have 2 copiers for people to use.
- DCS Info. Night went well. About 75 families attended. Admission policies are being reworked to be consistent with the other two Community Schools in LWSD. If one twin gets in, the other twin will get in as well. The policy will be updated online. Please refer to that for details. The secondary choice schools do not have a sibling policy.
- Budget: there is a shortfall again this year. DCS/Sandburg will be affected. More details to come on how that will affect our school.
- The LWSD website says that we will have a new building in 2012. This is not going to happen. The Capitol Improvements Bond pays for construction of new schools. It needs a 60% supermajority to pass. This will be voted on Feb. 9, 2010. The district will know more after the election.
- DCS portable has been leaking. This is being addressed.

Teacher's Report

- Diane: She reviewed the "Kelso's Choice" conflict resolution program that is being used at school. The school counselor will be coming into the youngers class soon to talk with the kids about it.
