## Cris P explained:

Steering Meetings are held the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month except July, and August is held the week before the Root Beer Social each year. Meetings are in the library, starting at 6:30pm unless otherwise posted; Steering Meetings are open to all adult members of the community and attendance is encouraged but not necessary.
