IslandWood next year: Sandburg organizers have asked if DCS would like both schools to go at the same time next year. General feeling at Steering was that it would foster the community between the two schools, as well as save on costs. Combining with Sandburg in the fundraising efforts will also help kids make connections prior to going to IslandWood. Concern was raised that DCS still wants to send the Olders class—including 4th graders—as part of their experience; Heather said that was a given. Steering is supportive of this.

Speaking of IslandWood, idea was put forward for there to be an Olders Fundraising Coordinator, to handle concessions at Fall Event, the Pie Sale at the Learning Celebration, and other IslandWood specific fundraisers (FYI: IslandWood requires the students themselves to raise at least some of the funds toward the trip). This year, the Olders room parents (Shelley and Katty) will lead this effort, but it may be best to have a separate position designated for this next year.
